



Pastoral Internship Application

General Instructions

Thank you for your interest in the pastoral internship offered by the First Baptist Church of Durham. FBC will accept 2-4 interns per semester. The FBC internship program is intended to prepare men for a life of fruitful, biblically-faithful vocational ministry. Each internship lasts roughly four months, and comes with a modest stipend designed to cover incidental expenses. - (3) Two letters of recommendation (one from a pastor)
If you are married, include a letter from a pastor who can describe your marriage and speak to its suitability for ministry. This letter must be confidential and sent directly by the pastor to the above address or via e-mail to andy.winn@fbcdurham.org.
- (4) Answers to the following questions:
 - a. How did you become a Christian?
 - b. In a half-page or less, describe your theological convictions.
 - c. Describe the circumstances of your baptism (setting, officiant, church involvement, etc.).
 - d. How did you learn about the FBC internship?
 - e. Why do you want to intern at FBC?
 - f. What do you hope to learn during the course of an internship?
 - g. Describe the church you currently attend and your involvement. (Include your spouse, if applicable.)
 - h. What kind of service do you think God is leading you into?
 - i. What dates do you prefer for an internship? (Fall or Spring/ Year)
 - j. If you are married, tell us about your marriage and any concerns you may have for it as you consider pastoral ministry.
 - k. Tell us something about yourself we would not learn from your resume.

FBC will gladly consider applications from men who show a passion and love for Jesus Christ; possess, by God's grace, a character of integrity; have the desire and potential to be an evangelical leader; and share FBC's commitment to the Baptist Faith and Message and historic evangelical Christianity. Interns must go through the membership process at FBC during their internship.
